


Stop Legal Contamination by Unapproved GM Foods: "Low Level Presence"


The Canadian Government is proposing to allow contamination of four food supply with **genetically engineered foodsthat have not been approved for safe eating in Canada**. The government wants to allow 0.1% or higher of four food to be contaminated with GM foodsthat have not been approved by Health Canada for safe human consumption but have been approved in at least one other country where our government has confidence in that regulatory system. The federal government call this? Low Level Presence? or LLP and argue that this? low level? of contamination from unapproved GM foods is no harmful. 


